



To Figure Pipe Apples & Cauldron Bubbles

For apples, use tube 12. Hold bag at a 90° angle. Squeeze, keeping tube tip buried in icing until apple is formed. Stop pressure, lift tube away. Shape with fingers dipped in cornstarch.

For bubbles, use tube 12 and same technique described for apples.

To Make Flame

Use tube 12. Apply a stripe of orange paste food color inside a parchment paper cone with an art or pastry brush. (It's best to use a parchment paper cone, since paste food color may stain your vinyl decorating bag.) Fill bag with golden yellow icing. Hold bag at 45° angle. Squeeze until icing builds up. Continue squeezing while moving bag upwards gradually easing pressure, tapering flames.

To Make Witch Hair

Use tube 18. Hold decorating bag at a slight angle to practice surface. Touch tube lightly to surface and squeeze. Pull tube out, away from surface and stop. Do *not* stop squeezing until you have pulled tube out 1/2" and away from surface.

To Make Farmer Hat

Use tube 18. Hold decorating bag at a 45° angle to practice surface, lightly touching surface. As you squeeze out icing with a steady, even pressure, move tube in a vertical direction laying out a ribbed stripe of icing. Stop pressure and pull tube away. Repeat procedure, making uniform stripes side by side. Use this method to cover hat. *To make farmer and witch pipes:* Use tube 16. Follow above directions, but as you squeeze out icing, jiggle tube in an up and down motion for a wavy effect.
