



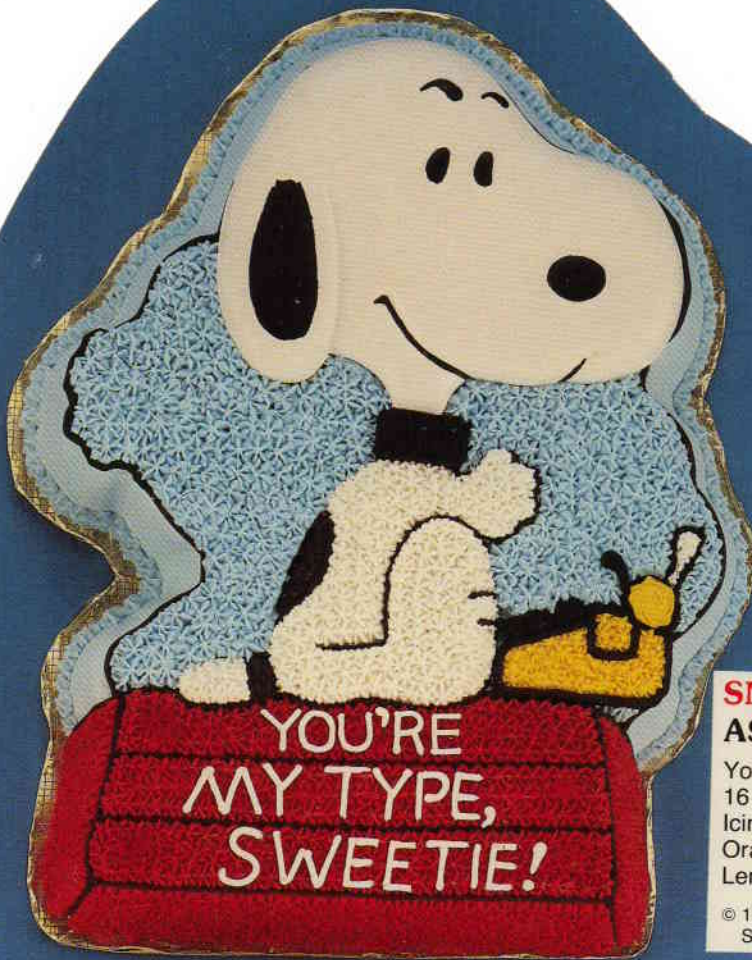

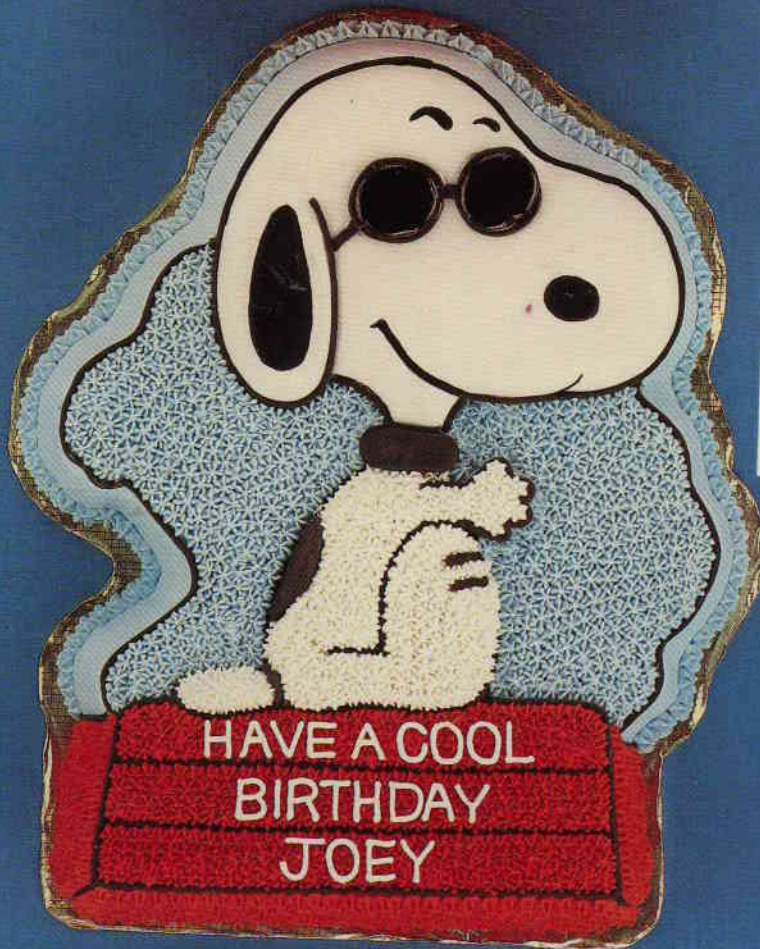

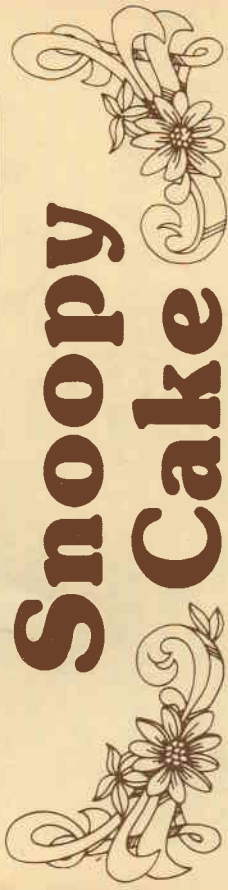

## Complete Instructions for Baking & Decorating

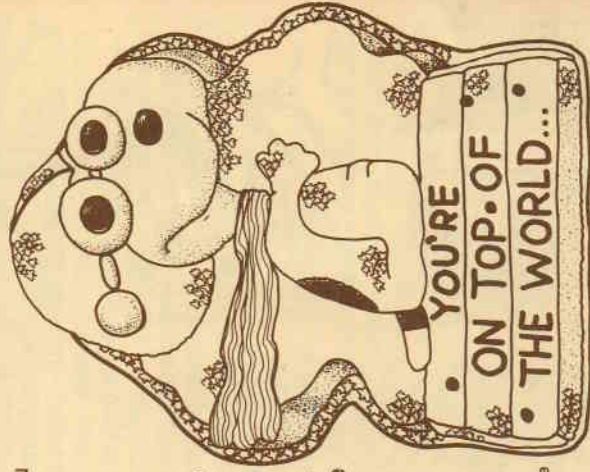
# Snoopy Cake



**PLEASE READ THROUGH INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE YOU DECORATE.**

To bake and decorate this cake you will need:

- Wilton Decorating Bag and Coupler or parchment paper triangles
- Tips 3, 12 and 16
- 2-layer cake mix or ingredients to make your favorite layer cake
- 4 cups buttercream icing (recipe in this booklet) or 2 packages of Wilton Creamy White Icing Mix or 3 packages of creamy vanilla-type frosting mix (15.4 oz. box)
- Wilton Paste Icing Colors in Sky Blue, Orange, Golden Yellow, Black and Brown.\*



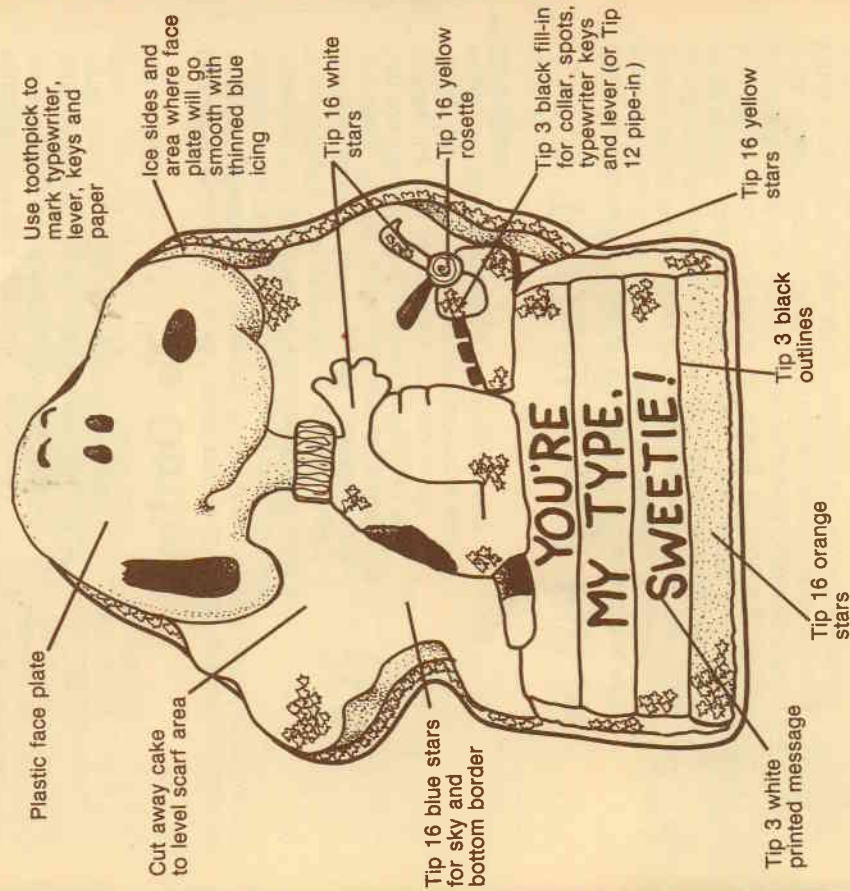
\*Note: If you are using a Wilton Decorating Kit, add Red Liquid Icing Color to yellow icing to make orange and add Blue Liquid Icing Color to brown icing to make black.



## To Decorate Snoopy, as Typist Cake

You will need tips 3 and 16 and Wilton Paste Icing Colors in Sky Blue, Orange, Black and Lemon Yellow.

- Tint 2 cups icing blue (thin 1 1/4 cups with 2 tps. milk or 1 Tbsp. corn syrup).
- Tint 1/2 cup icing orange.
- Tint 1/4 cup icing lemon yellow.
- Tint 1/2 cup icing black (or use very dark chocolate icing).
- Reserve 3/4 cup white icing.

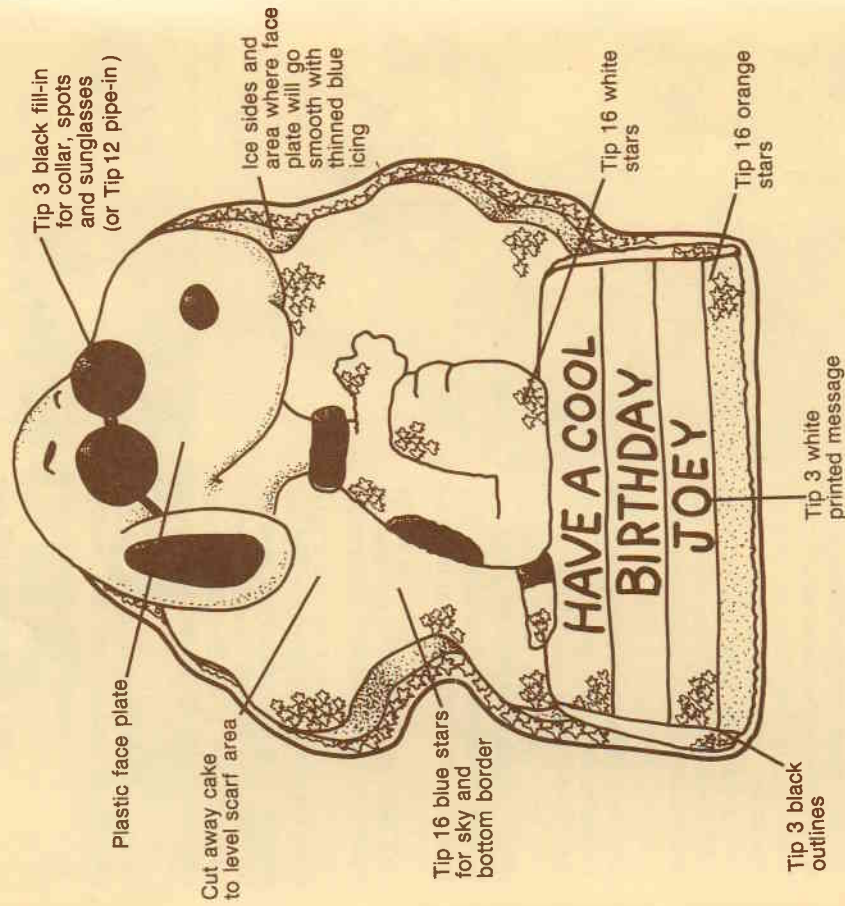

## To Decorate Snoopy, as Joe Cool Cake

You will need tips 3 and 16 and Wilton Paste Icing Colors in Sky Blue, Orange and Black.

- Tint 2 1/4 cups icing blue (thin 1 1/2 cups with 2 tps. milk or 1 Tbsp. corn syrup).
- Tint 1/2 cup icing orange.
- Tint 1/2 cup icing black (or use very dark chocolate icing).
- Reserve 3/4 cup white icing.

## To Decorate Snoopy, as Flying Ace Cake

To decorate the Snoopy cake featured on the pan label you will need tips 3, 12 and 16 and Wilton Paste Icing Colors in Sky Blue, Orange, Golden Yellow, Black and Brown. We suggest you tint all icings at one time, while cake cools. Refrigerate tinted icings in covered containers until you're ready to decorate.

- Tint 2 cups icing blue (thin 1 ¼ cup with 2 tps. milk or 1 Tbsp. corn syrup).
- Tint ¼ cup icing golden yellow.
- Tint ¼ cup icing brown (or use chocolate icing).
- Tint ½ cup icing black (or use very dark chocolate icing).
- Tint ½ cup icing orange.
- Reserve ½ cup white icing.

### WITH THINNED BLUE ICING

- Use spatula and "Icing Smooth" directions to ice cake sides and area where face plate will go smooth.

### POSITION PLASTIC FACE PLATE.

### WITH BLACK ICING

- Use tip 3 and "To Outline" directions to outline all details and goggles over face plate.
- Use tip 3 (or 12) and "To Fill-In" directions to fill in eyes and spots on back and tail.

### WITH BROWN ICING

- Use tip 16 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover helmet.

### WITH BLUE ICING

- Use tip 16 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover sky and to add star border.

### WITH GOLDEN YELLOW ICING

- Use tip 16 and "To Make Stripes" directions to pipe scarf.

### WITH ORANGE ICING

- Use tip 16 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover doghouse.

### WITH BLACK ICING

- Use tip 3 and "To Make Dots" directions to pipe bullet holes (flatten slightly with fingertip dipped in cornstarch).

### WITH WHITE ICING

- Use tip 16 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover body and tail.
- Use tip 12 and "To Pipe In" directions to pipe in rims of goggles.
- Use tip 3 (or 12) and "To Fill-In" directions to cover strap and button on helmet.
- Use tip 3 and "To Write or Print" directions to add your special message.
