Instructions for Baking & Decorating

Good-Time Clock Cakes

PLEASE READ THROUGH INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE YOU DECORATE.

TO DECORATE CAKES you will need:

- Wilton Decorating Bag and Coupler or parchment paper triangles.
- Tips 3, 16, 21.
- Wilton Icing Colors in Sky Blue, Pink, Violet (alternate ideas also use Lemon and Golden Yellow, Teal Blue, Red-Red, Leaf Green and Brown).
- One 2-layer cake mix or ingredients for favorite layer cake recipe
- Buttercream icing (recipe inside).



How To Decorate Good-Time Clock

You will need Wilton Icing Colors in Pink, Violet and Sky Blue; tips 3, 16, 21. We suggest that you tint all icings at one time while cake cools. Refrigerate tinted icings in covered containers until ready to use.

Make 4 cups buttercream icing:

- Tint 1/4 cup violet.
- Tint 1/4 cup light pink.
- Tint 1 cup pink.
- Tint 1 1/4 cups blue (thin 1 cup with 1 tablespoon light corn syrup).
- Reserve 1 1/4 cups of white.

WITH THINNED BLUE ICING

- With spatula, ice background area on cake top and sides smooth.

WITH VIOLET ICING

- Use tip 3 and "To Make Outlines" directions to outline eyes, tongue and mouth.
- Use tip 21 and "To Make Stripes" directions to pipe clock hands.
- Use tip 16 and "To Make Rosettes" directions to add center of hands.

WITH PINK ICING

- Use tip 3 and "To Make Outlines" directions to outline bells and feet.
- Use tip 3 and "To Pipe-In" directions to fill in tongue.
- Use tip 16 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover bells and legs.
- Use tip 21 and "To Make Stars" directions to edge face of clock.
- Use tip 21 and "To Make Shells" directions to edge base.

WITH LIGHT PINK

- Use tip 3 and "To Make Dots" directions to add cheeks.

WITH WHITE ICING

- Use tip 3 and "To Pipe-In" directions to fill in white of eyes.
- Use tip 21 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover face.

WITH BLUE ICING

- Use tip 3 and "To Pipe-In" directions to fill in rest of eyes and mouth.
- Use tip 3 and "To Make Dots" directions to mark hours.
- Use tip 3 and "To Make Beads" directions to edge background area on cake top.

WITH VIOLET ICING

- Use tip 3 and "To Make Beads" directions to add pupils to eyes.
- Use tip 3 and "To Make Outlines" directions to add eyebrows and lashes.
